- Intellectual property : fruits of innovation & creativity







- Innovators filed almost 3.17 million applications
- Grew by 5.8% from 2016





Hong Kong's strengths

- International financial services centre
- Sound legal system
- Robust IP protection regime
- Gateway to Mainland China
- Distinguished history of acting as facilitator/deal-maker in international trade & cross-border transactions
- Unique advantages to develop into IP trading centre in the Asia-Pacific region









Government initiatives in IP Trading

The Working Group on Intellectual Property Trading released 28 recommended measures in 2015 under 4 strategic areas

- I. Enhancing the IP protection regime
- II. Supporting IP creation & exploitation
- III. Fostering IP intermediary services & manpower capacity
- IV. Pursuing promotion, education & external collaboration efforts







Fostering IP Intermediary Services

- Facilitate provision of highly specialized professional services including IP dispute resolution services
- HK : International legal & dispute resolution services centre in Asia-Pacific region
- Promote & develop IP arbitration/mediation as a specialized area in HK's dispute resolution services









Potentials of mediation in IP disputes

- Three main areas of disputes in relation to IP rights:
 - Registrability/validity of IPR rights
 - Infringement
 - Contractual matters(e.g. licensing, assignment, employment issues)
- Substantial increase in IP litigation e.g. 1st instance civil IP cases filed in Mainland courts in 2017 increased by 47% from 2016

Potentials of mediation in IP disputes

Advantages of mediation

- Covers multi-jursidictional issues
- Expertise in relevant IP areas
- Confidentiality, especially patents and trade secrets
- Parties' control over procedures
- Decision-making lies with the parties and tailor-made solutions
- Amicable solution conducive to continued cooperation

Way forward

- Recommendations by Working Group on IP Trading :
 - Promote/develop use of mediation as a means to resolve IP disputes
 - Explore use of evaluative mediation on top of facilitative mediation
- Outline Development Plan for the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area (February 2019)
 - Promote dispute resolution (including arbitration & mediation) as a means to resolve IP disputes

Promotion and education

Joint efforts of the Department of Justice and the Intellectual Property Department

- Seminars/workshops to explore use of evaluative mediation in IP disputes (2015, 2016, 2017, 2018)
- Encourage IP intensive industries to join the "Mediate First" Pledge
- Promotion at regional level (including APEC & Mainland)
