Standard 40-hours Mediation Training Course is designed to balance the teaching of mediation concepts and skills with a number of designated role play exercises. Assistant Instructor (AI) will act as a role model to share best practices and plays an important function to help course students applying the skills taught in the class during role play exercise(s). AI can also be benefited from enhancing the understanding of mediation knowledge and skills during role play exercises.

The purpose of this workshop is to explain the role and to align the performance of all Als through a standardized process in giving feedback to course students. In addition, it is important for existing and new Als to attain certain performance quality in order to stay fit and well prepared for the forthcoming new accreditation standards imposed by the Hong Kong Mediation Accreditation Association Limited (HKMAAL).
